

1. UNITED STATES - ANTI-DUMPING AND COUNTERVAILING MEASURES ON  
LARGE RESIDENTIAL WASHERS FROM KOREA

A. REQUEST FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PANEL BY KOREA  
(WT/DS464/4)

- The United States is disappointed that Korea has chosen to request the establishment of a panel with regard to this matter.
- As we have explained to Korea, the measures identified in the request are fully consistent with U.S. obligations under the WTO Agreement.
- Further, the request describes certain issues that are not measures and are therefore not subject to WTO dispute settlement.
- For example, in addition to challenging the results of a completed anti-dumping investigation, the request purports to address future determinations in other types of proceedings that have not even been initiated.
- For these reasons, the United States is not in a position to agree to the establishment of a panel today.
